Conference themes

To reinforce through practice the principles reaffirmed in 2017, especially those that recognize:

- its diversity as intangible cultural values
- · the skills of carpenters and builders, their cultural knowledge and ancient traditions
- the continuous evolution of cultural values over time and the need to periodically verify how to identify the authenticity of the pieces
- The different local traditions, constructions techniques and points of view about heritage conservation by considering the diverse amount of methodologies and techniques to apply
- Wood as a container and content in the different heritages throughout history.

The Chiloé Archipelago, in southern Chile, will be the headquarters for the 24th IIWC International Symposium. Ten "comunas" form the 8.394 km2 of Chiloé. Its capital city, Castro, is located 1,200 km south of Santiago de Chile's City. Located at Parallel 42° and formed by 40 islands, Chiloé is the vivid reflection of the culture of timber construction.

Due to its insular geography, Chiloé was able to preserve its cultural characteristics as unique. In addition to its hundreds of churches constructed mostly entirely with wood (16 of them listed as World Heritage sites), the iconic image of the Islands is their stilt constructions located at the mouth of the Gamboa River or the riverside street Pedro Mont at Castro city.
